Treasury update:

- Hahn provided an updated financial statement. The Pack currently has \$5,395.46. Anticipated expenses include some additional Pinewood Derby costs, Blue & Gold celebration, camp-out and Graduation. The Pack should finish this year with a sufficient balance to support activities early next year before collecting dues again.
