 And now for the painful part of the meeting.

We had a very candid talk about what is going to happen to our Pack if the positions that are left open do not get filled. Positions left open are things that have been taken off of the Cubmaster list so that all jobs are more

manageable. There are a few different options if we do not fill the critical position of Cubmaster. Bryon will be off duty (again) as of January.

1. We split the pack and move into other local packs.
2. We fold the pack.
3. We have a rotating Den assigned to run the pack shows until we get a Cubmaster.

We decided to go with option 3 for now and hope that sooner rather than later the Cubmaster will volunteer.

Each person attending was asked to take a serious look at the people in their Dens and see if there was someone there hiding that would be a potential Cubmaster or other Committee member and refer them to Susan.

Susan will attend a Den meeting for each Den and have the parents off to the side for a mini-meeting with brownies or cookies to tempt them into choosing their volunteer position.

The committee talked about passing a resolution that each registered family must have a job in the pack. Either as a helper for Blue & Gold, Pinewood, etc, or as a primary role. There will be a limited number of "helper" positions and once filled they will have to pick from what's available left on the list. I think Susan is going to have this list available for the November meeting.

It was pointed out that the Pack Show is the primary responsibility of the Cubmaster, everything else has now been shifted off onto other committee members. The Pack Show can actually be run precisely out of the Program Helps book or from what you get out of coming to Roundtable training. Roundtable is Free! Handouts are Free! If you don't have the Program Helps magazine ask Susan and she'll get you a copy. You don't have to make up the show from scratch. Susan will also send out a calendar with what is happening month to month and what we need our Stand In Cubmaster to do for that month.

Each den will need to have a representative at each planning meeting, so if the Den leader can't make it for your Den please assign someone who can come and get information. The minutes are just a brief reminder and not meant to replace attendance.
